## Updated Guidance on Dewatering Regulations

When you are involved with a project that has a groundwater management challenge. To enable construction works, dewatering should be considered as a cost effective and environmentally conscientious method.

However, there is a requirement to begin the process of applying for suitable licences and consents, as soon as possible.

It is often a misconception that dewatering will be permissible under the Environment Agency (EA) exemption conditions for small scale dewatering (Regulation 5): <a href="https://www.legislation.gov.uk/uksi/2017/1044/regulation/5/made">https://www.legislation.gov.uk/uksi/2017/1044/regulation/5/made</a> However, this is not the case, since the exemption **does not** apply to wells, boreholes or wellpoints.

You legally cannot commence pumping until all required licences and consents are in place. Therefore, it is important that you are aware of this risk and leave sufficient time to obtain the required licences.
